Category 2: Youth multi-media competition (ages 11-18)

People in places - show how people use a building or space.

Abstract - show a building or space in an unexpected or abstract way, either by perspective and view, or focusing on smaller details or patterns.

Play - show play in action, or favourite areas where you play and how people use these spaces.

Contrast - show interesting contrast, this could be in colour, lighting or subject.

Urban Nature - show examples of nature in the built landscape, for example plants, trees, flowers and wildlife.

Media used can include photography and video in addition to other more traditional materials. Unfortunately 3d models cannot be accepted!

Send in, scan or take a picture of your artwork along with a short written description (max. 100 words) of what it shows and why you like this part of the estate.

All submissions will be exhibited on the estate in September as part of the next community exhibition!

Why? This information will help inform our design so we can create spaces that work well for you.

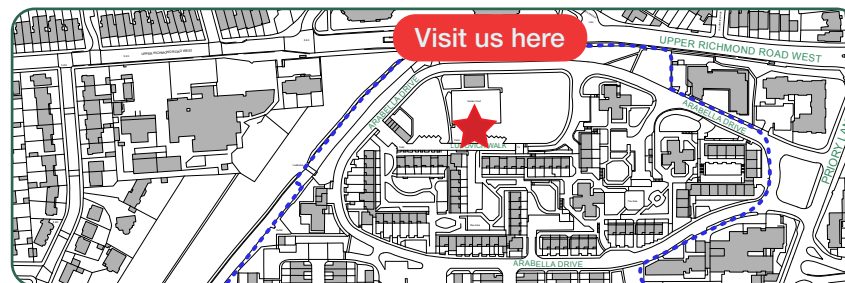

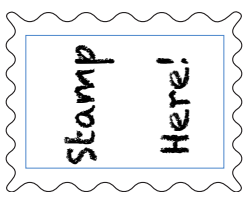
