Amna, a local Putney resident and wheelchair user, has moved into a new accessible home on the Kersfield Estate, part of the Homes for Wandsworth scheme. The home features automated door entry, level access, and ample space for wheelchair movement. The kitchen includes electric height-adjustable counters, hob, and sink, and there is a fully wheelchair accessible wetroom. "It's changed our lives so much in a better way," says Amna. "I'm so grateful for the thought and ideas put into this flat that benefit me so much."

If you are a council tenant or living in temporary accommodation and notice there is damp and mould in your property, you should contact the mould removal team.

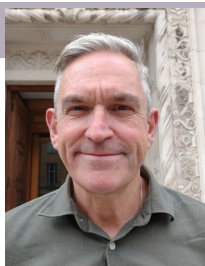
