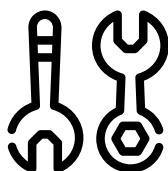
Come along to the Ark Academy open days on 22nd-26th September from 9-10:30am. Both events are at Pullman Gardens, London SW15 3DG

The Pharmacy First service gives people quicker and more convenient access to safe and high-quality healthcare directly from R Walji Pharmacy, 6 Rockingham Close, Lennox Estate, Putney, London, SW15 5RW.

The new service allows the pharmacy to help, advise and prescribe the appropriate medication for the following 7 conditions:

Condition	Age range
• Acute otitis media	1 to 17 years
• Impetigo	1 year and over
• Infected insect bites	1 year and over
• Shingles	18 years and over
• Sinusitis	12 years and over
• Sore throat	5 years and over
• Uncomplicated urinary tract infections	Women 16-64 years

Patients can be referred from GP surgeries, urgent and emergency care settings, and NHS 111 (online and via telephone); however, patients can easily access the service by attending or contacting the pharmacy directly without the need for referral on 020 8878 3386.
